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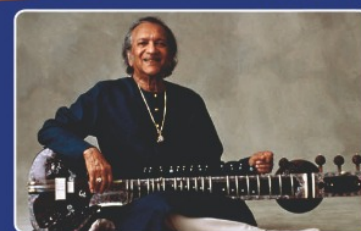
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PANDIT RAVI SHANKAR

Pandit Ravi Shankar was an Indian sitarist and composer. A sitar virtuoso, he became the world's best-known exponent of Indian classical music in the second half of the 20th century, and influenced many musicians in India and throughout the world.

In the course of his long career, Pandit ji became the most internationally known exponent of Hindustani (North Indian) classical music, performing with India's most-distinguished percussionists and making dozens of successful recordings. He composed 31 ragas, including Bairagi, Rasiya, and Banjara. In 1999 Pandit ji received India's highest civilian award, the Bharat Ratna. He also received the Padma Vibhushan (1981), the Padma Bhushan (1967), and the Sangeet Natak Akademi Award (1962). He won the Ramon Magsaysay Award in 1992.

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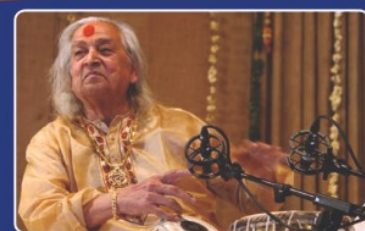
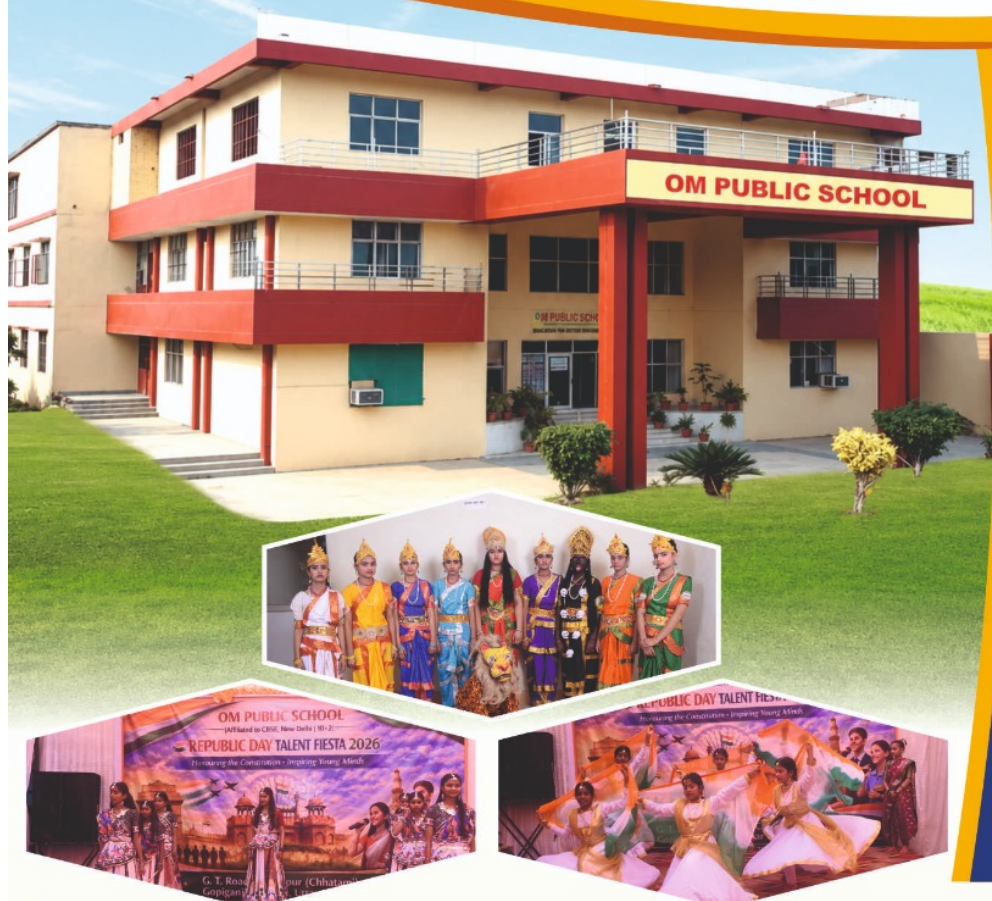
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PANDIT KISHAN MAHARAJ

Pandit Kishan Maharaj (1923–2008) was a legendary Indian Tabla maestro of the Benares gharana, born in Varanasi. Renowned for his unparalleled versatility and technical virtuosity, he accompanied top Hindustani musicians and revolutionized solo Tabla performance. He was honored with the Padma Shri (1973), Padma Vibhushan (2002), and Sangeet Natak Akademi Fellowship.

Born into a family of musicians in Kabir Chaura, Varanasi, he was trained by his father, Hari Maharaj, and later by his uncle, the renowned Pandit Kanthe Maharaj.

Known for his "Dumdaar" (resounding) style, he elevated the Tabla from a mere accompaniment instrument to a leading solo instrument.

He left a lasting legacy through his numerous students, including Kumar Bose and Pooran Maharaj.

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PT. RAJAN SAJAN MISHRA

Pandit Rajan Mishra (1951–2021) and Pandit Sajan Mishra (born 1956) were world-renowned Indian classical vocalists of the Banaras gharana, celebrated for their khayal singing. Born in Varanasi, they were trained under their father and uncles, performing globally for over four decades.

Mentors: Received training from their grandfather's brother, Bade Ram Das Ji Mishra, father Hanuman Prasad Mishra, and uncle Gopal Prasad Mishra.

Musical Style: Known for their deep, emotional, and technically profound Khayal singing, along with Tappa, Tarana, and Bhajans. Their first foreign concert was in Sri Lanka in 1978; they subsequently performed in Germany, USA, UK, France, and more.

They received the Padma Bhushan, Sangeet Natak Akademi Award, National Tansen Samman, Kashi Gaurav, and many more.

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GIRIJA DEVI

Girija Devi (8 May 1929 – 24 October 2017) was a legendary Indian classical vocalist known as the "Queen of Thumri" and a leading exponent of the Banaras gharana. She began training at age of five under vocalist Sarju Prasad Misra and later studied under Chand Misra.

Musical Style: She specialized in the Poorab-ang thumri style, incorporating nuances from the Banaras and Seniya gharanas. Her repertoire included Khayal, Tappa, Thumri, Dadra, Chaiti, and Kajri.

Career & Legacy: She made her debut on All India Radio in 1949 and taught at the ITC Sangeet Research Academy in Calcutta (1977–1990). She was known for bringing semi-classical music to the forefront of the classical stage.

Awards: She was honored with the Padma Shri, Padma Bhushan, and Padma Vibhushan, Sangeet Natak Akademi Award, and the Tansen Samman.

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PANDIT CHHANNULAL MISHRA

Pandit Chhannulal Mishra was a revered Hindustani classical vocalist from the Banaras Gharana, renowned for his mastery in Khayal, Thumri, and folk genres like Dadra and Kajri.

Mentorship: He was trained under Ustad Abdul Ghani Khan of the Kirana Gharana for 11 years and was a disciple of Pt. Thakur Jaidev Singh.

Genres: While a master of Khayal, he was a prominent exponent of the Purab-ang (eastern style) Thumri, Dadra, Chaiti, Kajri, and Bhajan. He was nominated by PM Narendra Modi as one of the nine Gems for the Clean India Campaign and was one of the proposers for Modi's 2014 Lok Sabha nomination from Varanasi.

A Sangeet Natak Akademi Award (2000), Yash Bharti Award (2000), Padma Vibhushan (2020), and Padma Bhushan (2010) recipient, he was a legendary figure in Indian music who passed away at age 89.

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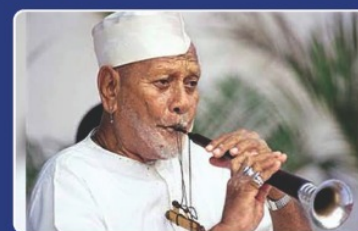
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USTAD BISMILLAH KHAN

Ustad Bismillah Khan (1916–2006) was a legendary Indian musician who elevated the **Shehnai** from a ceremonial folk instrument to a classical concert instrument. He was - trained under his uncle in Varanasi. His major breakthrough came in 1938 with the opening of All India Radio in Lucknow, after which he became a celebrated radio artist. Instrument Mastery: He is credited 'with bringing the shehnai, previously limited to weddings and temples onto the classical stage.

He famously played at the Red Fort on the eve of India's Independence in 1947 and on the first Republic Day in 1950.

He spent his life near the Ganges in Varanasi, embodying a composite culture, often playing at Hindu temples.

He was recipient of the Padma Shri (1961), Padam Bhushan (1968), Padma Vibhushan (1980) and was awarded the Bharat Ratna (2001).
